

“Primavera Enterprise (Advanced Topics)” Training Program (English Material)

Course Length: 16 Hours @ 4 days

Course Overview

This course is designed to give current Pve users a more in depth look at the software. The lessons can be performed independent of one another to allow flexibility in the course.
